



## JOB DESCRIPTION

### Position:

Green Infrastructure Technician – Civic/Commercial

### Purpose:

The Green Infrastructure Technician will work on the City-Commercial team on the installation and management of water quality and ecological projects. These projects will include Water Quality, Wet Ponds, Rain Gardens, Bioswales, Wetland Restoration, Park and Preserve Restoration, & Trail Design and Implementation

### Job Duties:

As a Green Infrastructure Technician, job functions may vary daily and may extend beyond the list below:

- Accurate and Efficient installation & maintenance of Green Infrastructure projects (as listed above) to include seeding, planting, weeding, trimming, mowing, watering, cleanup, erosion control
- Installation of high-quality naturalistic rockwork (limited)
- Working effectively and efficiently with crews of 2-10 employees
- Communicating project needs to the Crew Leader
- Maintenance of equipment as required
- Operating trucks, trailers and equipment with safety and efficiency
- Other duties as required

### Education and Experience Requirements:

- One (1) year prior experience in ecological restoration or conservation
- One (1) year prior experience with native plants and stormwater infrastructure
- *Other applicable experience may waive the above qualifications*

### Qualifications and Required Skills:

- Valid Texas Driver's License and "clean" driving record
- Must be able to lift up to fifty (50) pounds for brief or extended periods
- Strong attention to detail and organization
- Highly motivated with strong work ethic
- Strong communication skills
- Ability to work outside in extreme temperatures
- Ability to stand for extended periods of time
- Ability to move safely over uneven, unpaved, terrain
- Ability to stoop and/or kneel for extended periods of time
- Ability to lift 50-80 lbs, as needed
- An active interest in environmental issues

### Working Conditions:

- 90-95% of time in this position will be spent in outdoor setting

- 5-10% of time will be in transit, either private vehicle, or a company fleet vehicle

**Hours:**

- This will be a Monday-Friday position, from 7:30am-3:30pm. Hours may vary due to seasonal and business needs.

**Wage/Salary:**

- The starting wage for this position will be \$15.00 per hour.

**Benefits:**

- This position is eligible for full-time benefits including paid time off, holiday pay, healthcare, retirement accounts and other benefits as outlined by the employee handbook.

**Reporting Duties:**

- This position will report to Crew Leader and Project Managers. Primary Supervisor will be the Crew Leader of specific site.
